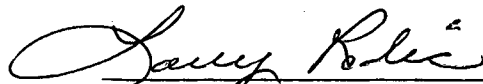
14 TO: THE HONORABLE COURT IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED CAUSE:

17 completion of his pleadings.

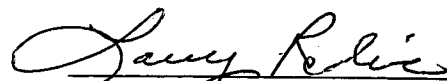
18 WHEREUPON, the application duly made in a timely manner, I
