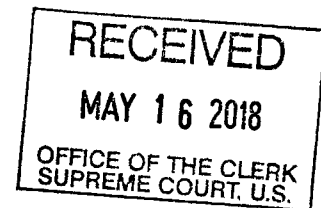

Dear Hon. Justice Clarence Thomas,

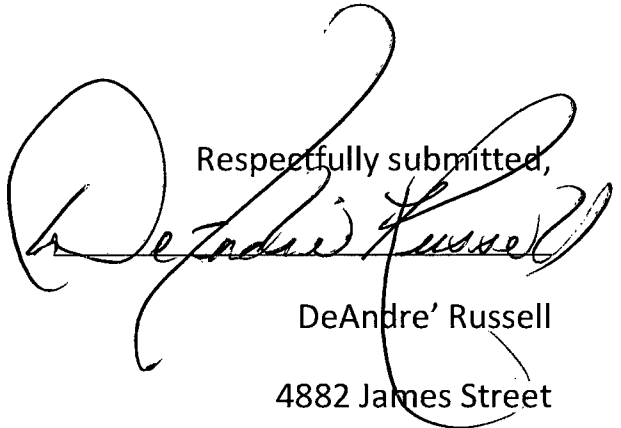
