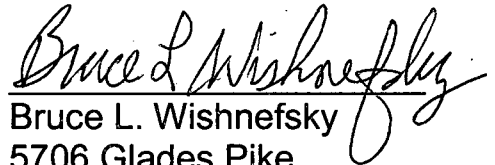

APPLICATION TO EXTEND THE TIME TO FILE
PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

The jurisdiction of the Court is invoked under 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1). The underlying case is under 42 U.S.C. 1983, and the Americans with Disabilities Act. The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit dismissed my case *Wishnefsky v. Salameh*, No. 17-1166 on December 27, 2017, after holding, based on its decision in *Parker v. Montgomery*, 870 F.3d 144 (CA3 2017), cert. denied, No. 17-779, 2018 U.S. Lexis 1790 (Mar. 19, 2018), that I was not eligible to proceed in forma pauperis. A timely application for rehearing en banc was denied on March 4, 2018. (Attached)

Therefore, the petition for a writ of certiorari is now due on June 2, 2018. Petitioner is requesting that the time to file be extended by 60 days,

as permitted by Rule 13.5, to August 1, 2018, because petitioner is incarcerated and has only limited access to the prison law library, which is often closed for unscheduled reasons such as prison lockdowns and security searches. Also, the Lexis research system on case law is updated on an irregular basis, for example at present the most recent Supreme Court federal cases are from March 22, 2018.


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
