Dear Pro Se Clerk,

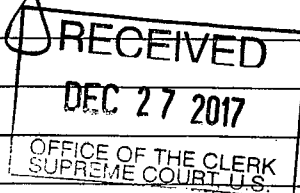
I am the appellant in the above-referenced matter representing myself Pro Se.

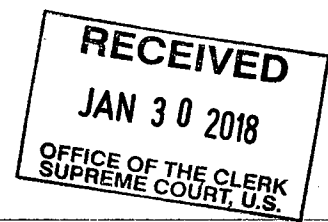
I pray that you grant this extension of time request. Thank you
