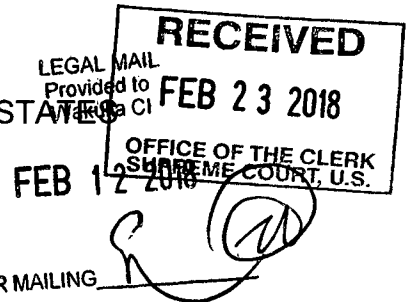

MOTION TO ACCEPT APPLICATION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AS TIMELY FILED

COMES NOW, Defendant, Lonnie Lee, *pro se* pursuant the letter from the office of the clerk dated January 31, 2018 and respectfully requests that the Court accept Petitioner's application for extension of time as being timely filed. In support of this request, the Petitioner offers the following:

The clerk returned Petitioner's application for extension of time because the lower court opinion was not appended. The clerk stated that it could not determine the timeliness of the application without the lower court opinion.

Petitioner's original Motion for Extension of Time was filed on January 16, 2018 with a copy of the lower court opinion included.¹ After filing, Petitioner found typographical errors. On January 23, 2018, Petitioner filed an "Amended Motion for Extension of Time." The amended motion did not include a copy of the lower court opinion.²

The Petitioner has included a copy of both the January 16, 2018 and the January 23, 2018 "DC5-154 Copy Service Request."³ The January 16, 2018 document

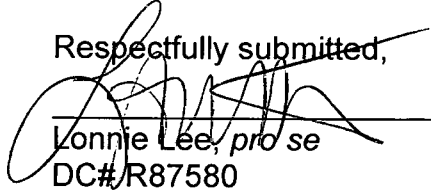

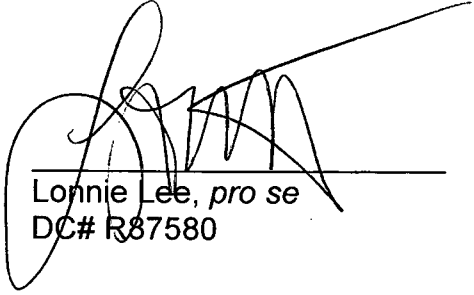

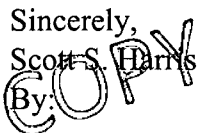
