Dear Mr. Harris:

On behalf of Respondent-Intervenor Aimee Stephens, I write to request an additional 30-day extension of time within which to file Respondent-Intervenor's brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari from September 24, 2018 to October 24, 2018.

Counsel for Respondent-Intervenor Aimee Stephens continues to face significant competing professional obligations. Among other obligations, Counsel has been completing fact and expert discovery, as well as numerous filings and other preparations for an October 9, 2018 jury trial date, in *Boyden v. Conlin*, No. 17-cv-264-wmc (W.D. Wis.). Counsel is also drafting a response brief in *Good v. Iowa Dept. of Hum. Serv.*, No. 18-1158 (Iowa), which must be filed in the Iowa Supreme Court on September 19.

These and other previously scheduled engagements and personal and professional commitments during the previous 30-day response period would make it difficult for counsel to prepare the response in this case on the current schedule.

The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on July 24, 2018, following a 59-day extension granted by Justice Kagan. Petitioner has advised Respondent-Intervenor that it does not object to this request for additional time.
