Dear Mr. Harris:

The Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (“PBGC”) is a wholly owned United States government corporation created by Title IV of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974, as amended (“ERISA”), 29 U.S.C. §§ 1301 – 1461, which establishes the pension insurance programs for single-employer and multiemployer plans. The petition for a writ of certiorari in this case was filed on April 2, 2019, after Petitioner had received two 30-day extensions to file. Although PBGC waived its right to file a response, the Court has requested that a response be filed. PBGC’s response is now due on June 7, 2019.

We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, an extension of time to and including July 5, 2019, with which to file PBGC’s response.

This extension is requested to complete preparation of PBGC’s response, which was delayed because of the heavy press of earlier assigned cases to the attorneys handling this matter.
