
Re: *June Medical Services L.L.C. v. Gee*, Nos. 18-1323, 18-1460 - Brief of Social Science  
Researchers as *Amici Curiae*

Dear Clerk of the Court:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 32(3), *Amici Curiae* propose to lodge with the Court copies of certain published articles cited in the Brief of Social Science Researchers as *Amici Curiae* in Support of Petitioners ("Brief"), which was filed with the Court on December 2, 2019. The Brief cites to dozens of published social science studies and articles, many of which are not publicly available without charge. As researchers in this field, and authors of many of the cited studies, *Amici Curiae* can provide the Court with copies of those published articles which are not publicly available.

This Court has often considered similar such material in its cases when relevant to the issues presented. See e.g. *Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pa. v. Casey*, 505 U.S. 833, 891-92 (1992) (relying on studies to support the District Court's findings of fact with regard to domestic violence); see also *Whole Woman's Health v. Hellerstedt*, 136 S. Ct. 2292, 2315 (2016), as revised (June 27, 2016) (citing several briefs of *amici curiae* relying on scientific studies). Review of the full studies may aid the Court's understanding and consideration of *Amici Curiae's* Brief.
