
Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent respondents in the above-captioned case. I write to request a 30-day extension of time to respond to the petition for a writ of certiorari, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4. On August 20, 2018, petitioner Zappos.com, Inc. filed its petition for a writ of certiorari. Respondents presently have until September 21, 2018, to file their response.
