Yesterday, Respondents requested a 60-day extension in which to file their Brief in Opposition in the above-captioned case. One justification they gave (at 3) was the need to “respond to the Petition for Rehearing En Banc by October 15, 2018.” The same day, and with Petitioners’ consent, Respondents asked the Eleventh Circuit for an extension to that deadline.
