I am writing to request a 30-day extension in the above referenced case to file response. Keon Thompson*, Case No. 3:18-cr-00314 - charged with conspiracy to commit kidnapping and felon in possession of firearm set for trial on December 10, 2018, and preparing for federal sentencing hearings: *United States v. Martha Arps*, Case No. 3:18-cr-00501, *United States v. Demond Lynn*, 3:17-cr-00567, *United States v. Zachary Dixon* Case No3:17-cr-00180, and *United States v. John Christopher Ware*, 3:15-cr-00494, set on November 8 and November 9, 2018.

For these reasons, the undersigned requests an extension of time to file a response until December 3, 2018.
