I represent respondent Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC ("MVP") in this matter. The petition for a writ of certiorari was docketed on October 30, 2018, and responses are due November 29, 2018.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, MVP respectfully requests an extension of 30 days to respond to the petition. I understand that respondent Federal Energy Regulatory Commission will seek a similar extension for its brief in opposition. If granted, the extensions will make the briefs of respondents due at the same time. The additional time will also enable respondents to review and respond as necessary to a brief of an *amicus curiae*, which MVP has been notified will be filed in support of petitioners. I should note that petitioners have informed MVP that they oppose any extension.
