As counsel of record for respondents in the above-captioned cases, I am writing to request a 14-day extension of time to file a brief in opposition in these related cases to and including December 17, 2018. The certiorari petition in No. 18-575 was filed on October 31, 2018, and docketed on November 1; the certiorari petition in No. 18-581 was filed on October 31, 2018, and docketed on November 2.
