
We are writing to request a 30-day extension of time for filing an opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed by Spirit Airlines, Inc. ("Spirit") in the above-referenced, up to and including February 8, 2019. Spirit's Petition for Writ of Certiorari was docketed on November 13, 2018 and Respondent's opposition brief is now due on January 9, 2019.

We have diligently attempted to meet the Court's deadline for filing an opposition to Spirit's petition but need an extension in order to provide sufficient time to prepare an opposition. The counsel of record has several pressing obligations to other clients which pre-date the filing of Spirit's petition. One such obligation is that Patrick Cooper and myself are preparing for a trial to be set in early 2019 in the Southern District of Illinois, *Suchanek v. Sturm Foods, Inc.*, 3:11-cv-00565-NJR-RJD. An extension will allow us to meet these obligations and file a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition for certiorari.
