Dear Mr. Harris:

On behalf of the State respondents, I request a 30-day extension, to April 19, 2019, of the time to file a brief in opposition to a petition for a writ of certiorari filed in the above-cited case. *See* Sup. Ct. R. 30.4. There is good cause for this extension in light of the pressing deadlines on numerous other matters handled by counsel assigned for the State respondents. Petitioners consent to this request.

Counsel for the State respondents have deadlines in other cases that were pending in other courts before this Court requested opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari. These matters include: *New Jersey Rifle and Pistol Clubs v. Grewal, et al.*, 3:18-cv-10507 (D.N.J.) (motion for summary judgment to be decided on April 2, 2019), *ABC Bail Bonds v. Grant*, A-3961-17T1 (oral argument heard on March 6, 2019).

In addition, this case involves a constitutional challenge to a state statute.

For these reasons, the State respondents respectfully request an extension of time to file its opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari until April 19, 2019.
