I represent the Respondents in the above-referenced matter. A Petition for a Writ of Certiorari from an October 15, 2018 decision was filed on January 11, 2019, and placed on the docket on January 15, 2019. On February 21 and March 22, 2019, this Court granted Respondents' unopposed requests to extend the deadline within which to file a Brief in Opposition.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondents respectfully request a final one-week extension of time to and including April 24, 2019 to file a Brief in Opposition. Immediately following Respondents' March 2019 request, the Sixth Circuit affirmed in *Liogghio v Salem Township*, warranting a petition for rehearing within the requisite 14-day time period. In addition, the opposing parties in two Michigan Supreme Court cases, *Hartland Glen v Hartland Township* and *Clyde v Hartland Township*, filed their Briefs in Opposition to Defendants' timely Applications almost four months after their due dates, causing another unanticipated conflict with the within briefing schedule for preparation of Defendants' Supreme Court Reply Briefs in those matters. Based on these new developments, in addition to all of the other matters previously pending and detailed, Respondents respectfully request a final one-week extension of time to file a Brief in Opposition.

This request is made in good faith and not sought for any improper purpose. I have conferred with Counsel of Record for Petitioner who does not oppose this extension.
