I write to you on behalf of Yali Acevedo Feliciano and 184 other plaintiffs in consolidated cases Nos. SJ2016CV00131, SJ2016CV00143 and SJ2016CV00156, filed before the Court of First Instance of Puerto Rico, who are respondents in the above-captioned matter.

Respondents previously informed the Court that the Catholic Church filed a petition for reorganization before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico, under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, case no. 18-04911-EAG-11. The bankruptcy proceeding filed by the Catholic Church was dismissed by the Puerto Rico Bankruptcy Court on March 18, 2019, under 11 U.S.C. § 1112(b)(4)(F), due to the Church's non-compliance with the filing and reporting requirements of the Bankruptcy Code. Appearing parties wish to inform the Court of this ruling. The Catholic Church filed a Notice of Appeal with the United States Bankruptcy Appellate Panel for the First Circuit, case no. 19-17. (See attached Notice of Appeal).
