The Amendment took effect on December 5, 1933. *U.S. v. Chambers*, 291 U.S. 217, 54 S. Ct. 434 (1934). To be precise, the 21st Amendment took effect on December 5, 1933 at 5:32:30 p.m. EST when Utah became the 36th state to ratify it. The final vote was 38-1.

App. 3

The Amendment was rejected by a convention in the State of South Carolina on December 4, 1933.

The electorate of the State of North Carolina voted against holding a convention at a general election held on November 7, 1933.
