ORDER AND NOTICE

The Court has duly considered applicant's Motion to Relieve the Office of Capital and Forensic Writs and to Appoint Substitute Counsel. The Court finds that the motion is well-taken and should be GRANTED. The Office of Capital Writs is hereby relieved as counsel of record.

The Court previously found that the defendant/applicant is indigent and appointed counsel for the purpose of pursuing a writ of habeas corpus under Article 11.071 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure. The applicant is currently confined on death row in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice's Polunsky Unit. Therefore, the Court finds that he remains indigent and requires appointed counsel. The Court hereby ORDERS that, effective immediately, Gretchen Sween is appointed counsel of record for applicant in this post-conviction proceeding arising from the above-referenced cause number.


