I represent Respondent in the above-captioned case. I write pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 29.6 to inform the Court that on April 3, 2020, United Technologies Corporation consummated a merger with Raytheon Company, under which Raytheon Company became a wholly owned subsidiary of UTC, and UTC changed its name to Raytheon Technologies Corporation.

In light of the merger, the revised caption for this case should now read *General Electric Company v. Raytheon Technologies Corporation*.

Also in light of the merger, the corporate disclosure statement in Respondent's forthcoming brief in opposition will be as follows: Raytheon Technologies Corporation has no parent corporation, and no publicly held company owns 10% or more of its stock.
