The United States' Brief in Opposition was filed on July 29, 2020. The Petition for a Writ of Certiorari was docketed on April 28, 2020. The petition, brief in opposition, and any reply brief is scheduled to be distributed for the Court's consideration no earlier than August 12, 2020.

We respectfully request, pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.5 and 30.4, and the Court's Order dated March 19, 2020, that the time for distribution of the petition, brief in opposition, and any reply brief to the Court for its consideration be extended for an additional 14 days, to no earlier than August 26, 2020. Petitioners' counsel needs additional time to file a reply due to difficulties relating to COVID-19, specifically: working 100% remotely with no administrative support; the additional time needed to accomplish business travel; and the additional burden of coordinating communication with co-counsel due to scheduling difficulties.
