The petition in the above-captioned matter was filed and placed on the docket on May 1, 2020. The respondents' brief in opposition was originally due June 5, 2020. Respondents requested and were granted a 31-day extension until July 6, 2020. Pursuant to Rules 15.3 and 30.4 of this Court, respondents Telefonaktiebolaget LM Ericsson and Ericsson Inc. hereby request an additional 29-day extension of time, to and including August 4, 2020, in which to file their brief in opposition. Counsel for petitioners has indicated that they consent to the extension.


