Dear Mr. Bickell:

I represent the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Under Law, which filed an *amicus curiae* brief on behalf of itself, The Leadership Conference on Civil and Human Rights and other civil rights organizations in support of Respondents in the above-listed case on September 20, 2021 (hereinafter, "Brief of Lawyers' Committee *et al.*").

We write to inform the Court that after the filing deadline for *amici curiae* had passed, we learned that one of the signatories to our brief, Equality California, had signed onto another *amicus curiae* brief filed in the same case. For this reason, we write to request that the Court redact Equality California from the Brief of Lawyers' Committee *et al.*, as referenced in the brief's appendix. Further, we wish to note that, as a result of such signatory's removal, references to "16" civil rights organizations on the brief's cover and page one (including footnote two) should be read to refer to fifteen civil rights organizations.
