Dear Mr. Harris,

I am counsel of record for petitioners in this case. Under the Court's Rule 15.5 and the case distribution schedule, the certiorari filings are set for distribution on October 7, 2020. Pursuant to the Court's order of March 19, 2020, regarding filing deadlines during the COVID-19 pandemic and Rule 30.4, we respectfully request a 14-day delay in distribution. This would set the papers for distribution on October 21, 2020.

We make this request due to difficulties related to the pandemic. In particular, due to local restrictions on in-person meetings and the like, the Stanford Supreme Court Litigation Clinic is operating in an almost entirely virtual format.
