



MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, David Anson Alandt, pursuant to Rule 39 of the Supreme Court of the United States, respectfully requests leave to file the attached Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Arkansas Supreme Court without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis.

Petitioner was declared indigent by order of the Saline County Court in 2017 prior to his bench trial and proceeded in forma pauperis in all subsequent proceedings in state court. 


H. FAILED ATTEMPTS TO SECURE LEGAL COUNSEL




