Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent petitioners in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to the Supreme Court Miscellaneous Order dated March 19, 2020, Petitioners respectfully request a seven day delay in distribution of the Petition for Certiorari in this action. Distribution normally would occur on April 1, 2020. Respondents' counsel, Gassan Baloul of Squire Patton Boggs LLP, has authorized us to state that Respondents consent to this request.

Petitioners require more time to file a reply due to the COVID-19 outbreak. As grounds for this requested extension, Petitioners state as follows: last week counsel was forced to suddenly close their offices in order to minimize risk of potential infection of their staff, and this disruption has impacted the production schedule of the reply brief. Additionally, counsel's printer has been forced to close some of their offices at different times and has a smaller staff available for printing demands, which has suddenly and drastically reduced the window available to produce the brief to allow for delivery to the Court in time for distribution.
