Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on February 28, 2020, and placed on the Court's docket on March 3, 2020. The government's response is currently due, as extended, on December 1, 2020.

We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension to and including February 19, 2021, within which to file the government's response.
