Dear Mr. Harris:

By way of this letter, Respondent Keith Yordy requests an additional extension of fourteen (14) days in which to file his brief in opposition to petition for writ of certiorari, making it due September 2, 2020. Respondent's current due date, after receiving an initial thirty (30) day extension and a second fourteen (14) day extension for a total of 45 days, is August 19, 2020.

The extension is necessary because, since requesting the second fourteen (14) day extension, I have experienced some health issues that required I take some time off and prevented me from finishing the brief in opposition. Additionally, since last Friday, August 14, 2020, I have experienced computer problems that were not resolved until Monday, August 17, 2020.
