Motion for Leave to Proceed *in Forma Pauperis*

Petitioner, Billy Joe Wardlow, respectfully requests that the Court permit him to proceed *in forma pauperis* on his Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals. Counsel was appointed to represent Mr. Wardlow in his initial state habeas corpus proceeding under Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Article 11.071 § 2, and in his federal habeas corpus proceeding under 18 U.S.C. § 3599 (formerly 21 U.S.C. § 848) in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas and the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit. Counsel continued to represent Mr. Wardlow *pro bono* in the subsequent habeas corpus proceeding in the court below because there is no right to counsel in such proceedings unless and until the Texas

Court of Criminal Appeals authorizes the trial court to consider the subsequent application.
