MOTION OF PETITIONERS FOR
LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH
PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX

Pursuant to Rule 26.8 of the Rules of this Court, the Acting Solicitor General, on behalf of petitioners, respectfully seeks leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. The question presented in this case is whether the detention of an alien who is subject to a reinstated removal order and who is pursuing withholding or deferral of removal is governed by 8 U.S.C. 1231, or instead by 8 U.S.C. 1226. The opinions of the court of appeals and district court are included in the appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari. In our view, no other

portion of the record merits special attention such as would warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix, and preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of this case. We are authorized to state that counsel for respondents agrees that a joint appendix is not necessary.
