The State of Maryland, by and through undersigned counsel, pursuant to U.S. Sup. Ct. R. 30.4, respectfully requests an extension of time within which to file the brief in opposition to petition for writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case through and including December 4, 2020.

Lloyd Harris' petition for writ of certiorari was docketed in this Court on August 3, 2020, on August 13, 2020, the State waived their response, and on September 3, 2020, this Court requested a response from the State to be filed by October 5, 2020.

An extension of this deadline is necessary because the case needs to be assigned to a new attorney.
