I represent petitioner Oracle America, Inc. in the above-captioned case. On January 29, 2021, the petition for a writ of certiorari was filed. On May 3, the United States filed its response; respondent Amazon Web Services, Inc. filed a waiver of its right to respond on the same day. Oracle filed its reply to the United States on May 17. On May 19, the Court requested a response from Amazon, which was filed on June 18. Earlier today, Oracle filed its reply to Amazon.
