We represent respondents Chicago Teachers Union and American Federation of Teachers (“the Union Respondents”) in the above-referenced matter, which was docketed May 13, 2021. We write, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, to request a 30-day extension of time in which to file the Union Respondents’ brief in opposition to the pending petition for certiorari. The brief in opposition is currently due June 14, 2021. The requested extension would make the brief due July 14, 2021.
