The Court has requested that the respondent, District Attorney Rachael S. Rollins, file a brief in response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the referenced case by August 5, 2021. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Ms. Rollins respectfully requests that her time to file such a brief be extended by 60 days, to October 4, 2021.
