Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent the State of New Mexico ex rel. Hector Balderas, Attorney General, respectfully moves for an extension of time, up to and including November 5, 2020, in which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned matter.
