The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on August 27, 2020. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on November 2, 2020. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including November 6, 2020, within which to file a response.
