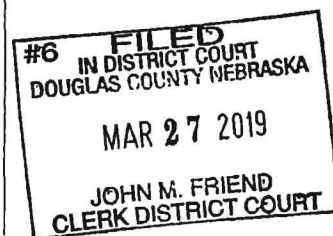

MOTION FOR NEW TRIAL

COMES NOW the Defendant, Augustine Cavitte , by and through her attorney, Bethany Stensrud, Assistant Public Defender, and pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 29-2101 and 29-2103 et seq. moves the court to issue an order for a new trial on the following grounds that materially affected the defendant's substantial rights:

1. That there were irregularities in the proceedings of the Court, the prosecuting attorney, and the witnesses for the State prejudicial to the rights of the Defendant;
2. That there were abuses of discretion by the trial court which prevented the Defendant from having a fair trial;
3. That the verdict was not supported by sufficient evidence;
4. That the verdict is contrary to law;
5. That the errors of law on the part of the trial court prevented the Defendant from having a fair trial;
6. That the Court erred in giving the instructions herein and in giving each of said instructions;
7. That the Court erred in not sustaining Defendant's motion for directed verdict made at the close of the State's evidence;
8. That there was misconduct of the jury which prevented the Defendant from having a fair trial;



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9. That there was misconduct of the prosecuting attorney which prevented the Defendant from having a fair trial;
10. That there was error of law occurring at the trial with prevented the Defendant from having a fair trial.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant prays that the Court to issue the above requested order.
