ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTIONS TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS AND FOR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL

Petitioner Erica Yvonne Sheppard is a death row inmate, currently in the custody of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. She has filed motions for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* and for the appointment of counsel to assist her in filing a petition for a writ of habeas corpus.

Title 18 U.S.C. § 3599(a)(2) provides for appointment of counsel in a habeas corpus proceeding when the petitioner is financially unable to obtain adequate representation on his own. Sheppard's is financially unable to obtain representation.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Sheppard's Motions For Leave To Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* (Docket Entry 1 and 3) and for Appointment of *Pro Bono* Counsel (Docket Entry 2) are GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that W. Alan Wright, Esq. and the law firm of Crouch & Ramey, LLP, 2001 Ross Avenue, suite 4400, Dallas, TX 75201, are appointed to represent Sheppard *pro*

bono in this habeas corpus proceeding.
