I represent Respondent in the case referenced above. Petitioner Oklahoma filed petition for a writ of certiorari on October 30, 2021, and this matter was placed on the docket on November 2, 2021. Respondent's response to the petition is due on December 2, 2021. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I write to request a fourteen (14) day extension of time to file a response to the petition in this case.

In light of the press of other business, counsel requires additional time to complete the response to the arguments presented in the petition. In particular, undersigned counsel is presenting argument in a preliminary-injunction hearing that was just set for Friday, December 3, in *North Carolina League of Conservation Voters, Inc. v. Hall*, No. 21 CVS 015426 (Wake Cnty., N.C.)—which challenges the congressional and state legislative maps recently enacted by the North Carolina General Assembly. Moreover, because the Court already has before it several dozen petitions raising identical issues, this extension will not delay the Court's consideration of these issues.
