Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time in which to file its brief in opposition to George Kayer's petition for certiorari in this Court, to and including February 7, 2022. The current deadline to file the brief in opposition is January 7, 2022. Undersigned counsel has contacted Jennifer Garcia, counsel for petitioner, and she has indicated that she has no objection to the requested extension.

The extension is necessary due to counsel's responsibilities in other capital matters, including assisting counsel in preparing for oral argument before this Court in *Shinn v.
