I represent the Respondents in the above-captioned case, in which the Court, on January 11, 2022, requested a response due February 10, 2022. I respectfully request a 30-day extension of time, to and including March 14, 2022 (thirty days ends on Saturday, March 12), in which to file a response. The recent Omicron outbreak of COVID-19 has led my firm to suspend in-office operations, with attendant delays and inefficiencies. Additionally, I have substantial professional obligations between now and the current due date, including an opening brief in *Viking River Cruises, Inc. v. Moriana*, No. 20-1573 (U.S.) (due Jan. 31), an oral argument in *FERC v. Ultra Resources, Inc.*, No. 20-20623 (5th Cir.) (Feb. 3), and an opening brief in *United States v. Hamilton*, No. 21-11157 (5th Cir.) (Feb. 11).
