On behalf of petitioners Amgen Inc., *et al.*, in the above-captioned case, we hereby provide the Court with petitioners' position on the motion of Chemistry and the Law Division of the American Chemical Society ("CHAL") to participate in oral argument as *amicus curiae* and for divided argument. The motion, filed on January 3, 2023, seeks five minutes of the argument time allocated to petitioners or five minutes of an expanded period for oral argument.
