MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH  
PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX

Pursuant to Rule 26.8 of the Rules of this Court, the Solicitor General, on behalf of the petitioners, respectfully seeks leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. The question presented is whether respondent's claims challenging his former placement on the No Fly List are moot. The opinions of the lower courts, the operative complaint, and certain portions of the record are appended to the petition for a writ of certiorari.

In our view, no other portion of the record merits special attention such as would warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix, and preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of this case.

Counsel for respondent has indicated agreement that a joint appendix is not necessary.
