We represent each of the respondents in this case, except for Briggs & Riley Travelware LLC (“Briggs”) and Delsey Luggage, Inc. (“Delsey”). Both Briggs and Delsey join in this request.

We write to request a thirty-day extension of the current August 8, 2022 deadline for respondents to file their brief in opposition to the petition for certiorari. The reason for this request is provide respondents an opportunity to address arguments to be made by *amicus curiae*. On July 26, 2022, respondents received 10-day notice from counsel for US Inventor and Eagle Forum Education & Legal Defense Fund (“US Inventor”) of its intent to file an *amicus curiae* brief in support of petitioner. Both petitioner and respondents have consented to US Inventor’s anticipated brief. Under Rule 37(2)(a), US Inventor’s brief is not due until August 8, 2022.

The requested thirty-day extension, until September 7, 2022, will allow respondents to address, in their brief in opposition, any arguments made by US Inventor (and any additional *amicus curiae*) supporting petitioner. This is respondents’ first request for an extension on their brief in opposition. Petitioner consents to this extension request.
