Dear Mr. Harris:

We are counsel for the referenced respondents in this case. Petitioners filed their petition for a writ of certiorari on October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a response is currently due November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by 45 days, up to and including December 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2022.

This is respondents' first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. Respondents' attorneys are solo practitioners whose already busy schedule have been affected by several weather related and electric power failure events in Puerto Rico. Due to the hardships and calendar conflicts caused by the mentioned situation, the response will require us to devote substantial amounts of time in the coming weeks. In addition, the response was to be reviewed by some colleagues who offered to aid us in the process, but have recently informed us of a conflict that precludes them from intervening in the case. Also, counsel Axel Vizcarra-Pellot's admission to the bar of this Court is still pending. For the above stated reasons, an extension of time is needed and would better enable preparation of a response that would be most helpful to the Court.


