Dear Mr. Brickell:

I am counsel for the respondents in the above-referenced case. On November 4, 2022, a certiorari petition was filed in this case. On November 18, 2022, the Court granted my request for a thirty-day extension, to and including January 6, 2023, to file a response.

I now seek an additional thirty-day extension, to and including February 6, 2023. The additional time will enable me to consult with my clients, who are all Members of the House of Representatives and occupied with official business and the forthcoming reorganization of Congress, and to ensure that I am able to file a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition. The requested extension is unlikely to affect the timing of the Court's consideration of the case on the merits if the Court were to grant the petition.
