RULE 29.6 DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Great Lakes Insurance SE is a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Federal Republic of Germany, with its office and principal place of business located in the Federal Republic of Germany (commercial register number: HRB 230378). Great Lakes Insurance SE is a wholly owned subsidiary of Munchener Ruckversicherungs-Gesellschaft (stock ticker symbol MUV2:GR Xetra), a company incorporated in Germany with its principal place of business in Munich, Germany.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 26.8, the parties respectfully seek leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. Counsel for respondent agrees that a joint appendix is unnecessary in this case, and has authorized counsel for petitioner to file this motion.

The question presented is a question of law: whether, under federal admiralty law, a choice-of-law clause in a maritime contract can be rendered unenforceable if enforcement is contrary to the “strong public policy” of the State whose law is displaced. The appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari includes all of the relevant lower court opinions and orders. The parties do not believe that any other portion of the record merits special attention that would warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix. Accordingly, a separate joint appendix would not materially assist in the Court’s consideration of this case.

For the foregoing reasons, the motion to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix should be granted.
