**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH PREPARATION OF
JOINT APPENDIX**

Under Supreme Court Rule 26.8, Petitioners move for leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix in this case. Respondent agrees that a joint appendix is not necessary.

The question presented is whether the National Bank Act preempts the application of state escrow-interest laws to national banks. The opinion and orders of the lower courts are reproduced in the appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari. The relevant portions of the underlying statutes involved will be reproduced in an appendix to Petitioners' merits brief. The parties agree that no other portion of the record merits special attention to warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix, and that preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court in its consideration of the case.
