RE: *Anna St. John, v. Lisa Jones, et al.*, No. 22-554 – Motion to Extend the Time to File Opposition to Petition for Writ of Certiorari

Dear Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondents Lisa Jones, Horacio Torres Bonilla, and Kristoffer Yee (collectively, “Respondents”) hereby apply for an extension of time of 30 days for filing a Brief in Opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari. If this requested extension is not granted, then the deadline for the filing and service of Respondents’ Brief in Opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari will be due Thursday, January 17, 2023.

In support of this application for an extension of time to file the Brief in Opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, Respondents submit the following specific reason that justify granting this request:

- 1. The amount of time requested for extending the filing and service deadline for the Brief in Opposition to the Petition is only 30 days, compared to Petitioner’s 120 days.**

Although a Petitioner has 90 days to prepare, file and serve a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, a Respondent has only 30 days from when the case is placed on the docket to file a Brief in Opposition to the Petition. In this case, Petitioner filed an application for an extension of time to file a Writ of Certiorari, which was granted on November 7, 2022. Respondents only have one-

Therefore, for the foregoing reason, Respondents respectfully request that the Clerk grant this application for an extension of time (30 days) to and including Thursday, February 16, 2023, to file and serve Respondents' Brief in Opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari, which Opposition is otherwise due on Thursday, January 17, 2023.
