Petitioner, Richard Eugene Glossip, by and through undersigned counsel, asks leave to file in this Court without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Counsel of record has been appointed as his counsel under 18 U.S.C. § 3599. ECF 91, *Glossip v. Sirmons*, No. CIV-08-0326-HE (W.D. Okla. Sept. 26, 2022). That appointment includes pursuing this litigation. *See Harbison v. Bell*, 556 U.S. 180 (2009). He was determined to be indigent and appointed counsel on that basis in the underlying conviction as well as the related appeal, and post-conviction proceedings pursuant to state law. *See* 22 Okla. Stat. § 1355 et seq. Because counsel was appointed due to Mr. Glossip's indigency, under Supreme Rule 39, no affidavit is needed.
